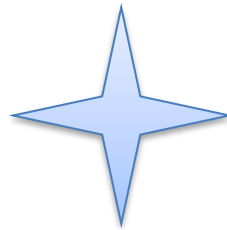
Pudsey and Shoebox Filling Day
