Parents' Evenings

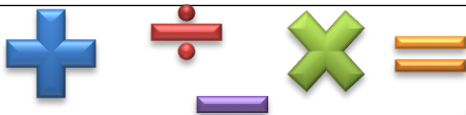
Thank you for returning your parents' evenings request slips. Your appointment times are being sent home in book bags today. Please let us know if yours does not arrive home safely.

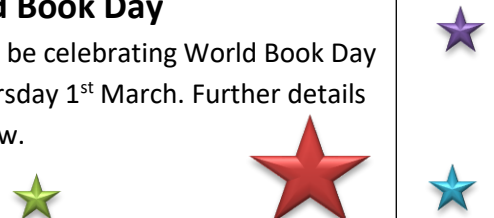
Messy Church
