Aid to Syria Update ~ *A message from Carrie Darke*

Dear Mrs Dalziell, and the Staff and Children of Hyde Primary School

I would like to thank you, and all the members of the Hyde School Community, who made dignity bags to send to Syria, for their generosity in supporting this aid effort. Every gift we send will not only bring physical comfort, but also send a message of love and hope to these truly traumatised people.

With your support we had a very successful collection day on Saturday 19th May. On the following Monday we delivered a staggering 84 boxes and at least 10 large bags of clothes, bedding, hygiene items, dignity bags for women and smiley bags for children, as well as Zimmer frames and crutches, to the hub in north Somerset. In addition, we raised enough funds to cover the cost of all the transportation and will be making a very generous donation to the "Orphans and Widows Fund". As this charity is run entirely by volunteers, every penny we give is used for the benefit of the Syrian people.

From the collection hub our aid was collected on Saturday 26th May and will travel first by sea to Turkey and then over land to Syria. It is expected that this shipment will arrive in Eastern Ghouta in mid July.

We will be making another collection in the Autumn, focusing on smiley bags for children, in addition to our usual collection items, and would be hugely grateful if across the summer you could put by items that we can send in the next shipment.


