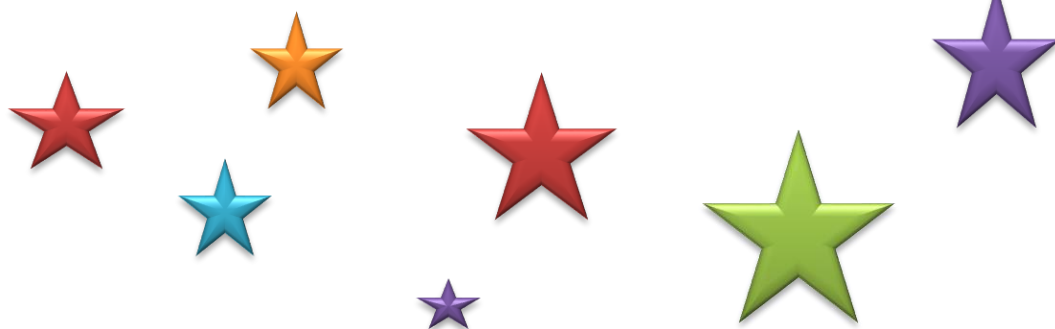


Handball Tournament
