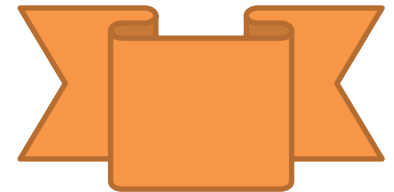
Please continue to help your child to learn their Nativity Service words and songs. Many thanks.
