Everyone who took part in the Summer Show are stars of this week!

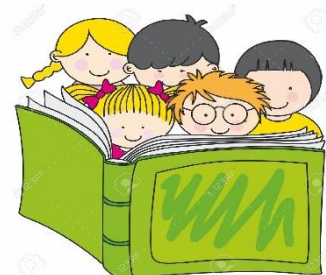
Our Stars of the Week are chosen by teachers in recognition of positive learning attitudes, positive behaviour or academic achievement.

Messy Church ~ End of term session

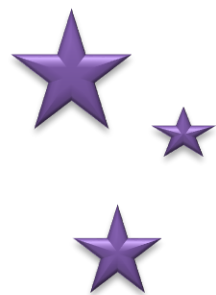
Monday 15th July 3.30 – 5pm, outdoors on the cricket ground
