## Attendance

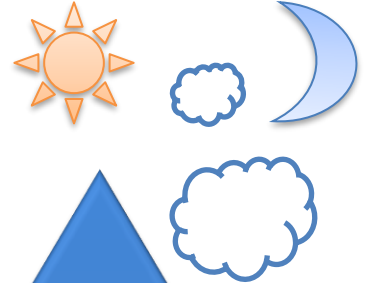
The current whole school attendance rate from the start of the school year to Friday 14<sup>th</sup> September is 97.59%.



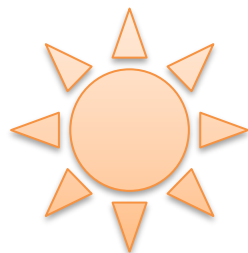
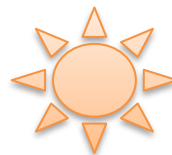
