Dear Parents

End of the day arrangements for collection of children :

Your child's safety is of paramount importance and their leaving the school site safely at the end of the school day needs careful supervision by parents or other accompanying adults. This is a reminder of the arrangements for the collection of children at the end of the day.

Class 1: The children must be collected from the side door of the school and supervised by parents or other accompanying adult as they leave the school site.

We have been made aware of pupils running off the school site and across the road without parental supervision. Please ensure your child walks with you until you have left the site and safely crossed the road.

Classes 2 and 3: The children must be met at the school gate near the Quiet Area and accompanied across the road by the adult who has collected them.

The gate at the school office end of the building, marked "No Exit For Pupils", should only be used by parents and not by unaccompanied children. We have reiterated this with the pupils and ask that you help us by shutting this gate after use. Thankyou for your help and support.
