The current whole school attendance rate from the start of the school year to Friday 2nd November is 95.43%.

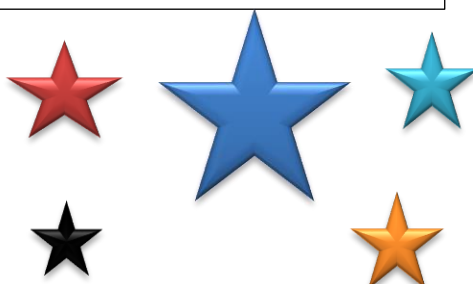
