Nativity Services

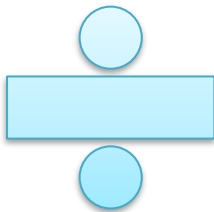
Attendance

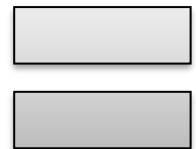
