- **New clothes:** hat, gloves, scarf, socks, underwear, baby-grows, t-shirts
- **Stationery:** pens, pencils, notepads, erasers, colouring and sticker books
- **Toiletries:** soap, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrush, facecloth, sponge, comb, brush, deodorant (roll-on only), razors, shaving foam
- **Other:** Sweets, make up (new only), sewing kits, candles, small household tools, hair accessories.

Please send donations into school on the day.

Ahead of the shoebox filling we need to collect as many empty shoebboxes as possible. It will be very helpful if you could cover the boxes with Christmas paper before bringing them in, but if you are unable to do so please don't worry.
