## Assessments

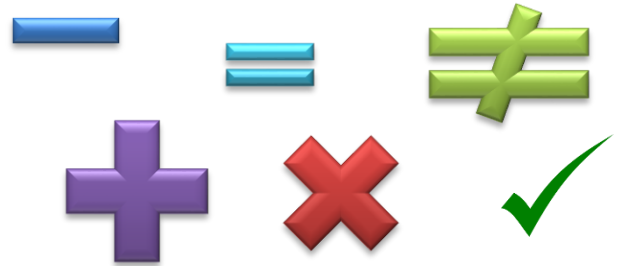
