New Forest Parks Assembly

Chris' Visit – New Forest Ranger

On 17th of January, our school was visited by Chris, a New Forest Ranger. She came to talk to us about looking after the forest. She did a special assembly in which she read a short story about what would happen if animals produced plastic waste like us humans do. What would the forest look like? More importantly what would the world look like? Luckily for us the animals only produce natural and biodegradable things because of all the plants they eat. Chris said that if we drop plastic in the forest and the animals eat it, what they produce will be partly plastic too.

After the assembly Chris came into our different classes to do activities with us. We made forest pledges and made little dolphins on sticks to represent the fact that more than half of our plastic waste can eventually end up in the sea! It was a really interesting afternoon and made us all stop and think about the plastic we use in our day to day lives. Do we really need to buy onions, bananas and oranges which are wrapped in plastic bags, when they already have a protective skin that we don't eat? Her message was that small changes can make a big difference and will help to protect the forest and our planet.
