Attendance : Your child's attendance certificate for the current academic year to 7th April is being sent home in book bags today.

We aim for each child to have attendance as close to 100% as possible, and certainly above 95% by the end of the academic year. Intermittent absence and broken weeks' education have a detrimental effect on both academic progress and social development so regular attendance is of vital importance.

The current whole school attendance rate from the start of the school year to Friday 7th April is 94.61%.
